- CRAFTERS RULES & REGULATIONS**
1. Send your application along with 3 slides or 4x6 photographs of your works. If you have photos on file and want to add new items, send photos of new items only.
 2. The review committee will consider all applications of handcrafted items only. Any buy and sell items are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**. Only items listed on application are to be offered for sale (new items must receive prior authorization)
 3. Upon acceptance, a non-refundable booth fee of \$400 is due. Do not mail any money until you receive an acceptance letter.
 4. If you require receipt books, you will need to bring them, as the Georgia Mountain Fair will no longer provide them.
 5. The craft committee will assign booths, an every effort made to vary the type of craft by location to maximize sales.
 6. Credit card service is available at the Craft Office for a fee of 5% per transaction (American Express, Discover, Master Card and Visa). The minimum charge purchase is \$10.
 7. All booths must be opened and manned during operating hours.
 8. GMF will provide twenty-four hour security, but is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
 9. Nearby parking is provided for crafters. Vehicles are strictly prohibited in the craft area during hours of operation.
 10. Overt solicitation and selling items outside your area is not permitted.
 11. Exhibitor's attire and behavior must adhere to the overall family-oriented theme of the show. The Georgia Mountain Fair reserves the right to determine what constitutes proper attire and behavior.
 12. All booths are required to maintain a fire extinguisher at all times.
 13. Booth alterations are not allowed without written authorization.
 14. Violation of regulation may be adequate grounds for prompt closure of exhibit.
 15. Exhibitors cannot sublet or apportion space to anyone else.
