The Georgia Mountain Fairgrounds would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for their hard work and dedication in making the 2011 Season a success and to introduce Russ Collins, our new Craft Manager with over 30 years experience. We are now in the planning stages of our 2012 shows and are pleased to introduce our exciting new changes. Our main goal is to return the Georgia Mountain Fair to where it once was, with a focus on handmade Arts & Crafts with demonstrations. We strongly urge all exhibitors to demonstrate.

1. The fair has always begun the 3rd Wednesday of July. The first 2 days have been dropped and the last Sunday has been added back to make it a 10-day event - July 20-29, 2012. The last Sunday has been added back to the Fall Festival making it 10 days as well - October 12-21, 2012.
2. All applications must be signed and returned by the deadline for consideration in the event. We ask that all concerns, compliments or suggestions be written and returned with your application. All written statements will be forwarded to the jury committee to answer any questions or resolve any issues or concerns that you may have.
3. Strict jury guidelines will be enforced so only quality artists and crafts people will be accepted. Absolutely no buy/sell will be tolerated in craft area. Commercial exhibitors will be in a designated area.
4. There will be a designated parking area for all exhibitors (no parking behind the music hall).
5. No items are allowed outside the overhang of booth.
6. All policies, rules and regulations will be clearly communicated and strictly enforced.

Again we appreciate the commitment and dedication of our crafters to make each of our events a bigger success. We look forward to working with you in 2012.
